Taxes and fuel charges totaling **\$691** USD comprised of **\$360.60** for fuel charges (subject to airline increase up to 30-days before departure) and **\$330.40** for taxes (including U.S. federal inspection fees, airport taxes international air transportation tax, agricultural tax, other government-imposed fees such as the September 11th Security fee up to \$10 per person, passenger facility charges up to \$18 per person, federal domestic flight segment fees up to \$3.50 per segment and U.S. and International arrival and departure, and other government imposed fees up to \$300 per person).

NOT INCLUDED IN PRICE:

Passports, visa/ETA, vaccinations (if required), laundry, lunches not on the tour menu (food outside of the contracted menu will be billed prior to leaving the hotel or restaurant), excursions not listed, telephone/international data, mini-bar, alcohol, other beverages, airport transfers on non-qualifying flights, portage at airports, excess baggage fees, additional airline fees after registration, travel insurance, and all other items not explicitly mentioned.

PAYMENTS & FEES:

A non-refundable deposit of \$500 per person is due upon registration, with a second deposit of \$500 per person required within 21 days thereafter.

Credit cards are only accepted for the initial \$500 deposit; subsequent payments must be in check, ACH transfer, bill payment, or wire transfer;

all payments are required in US Funds.

Final payment is due no later than 120 days prior to departure.

Registrations after 120 days require full payment and may incur a \$300 late fee if received 119-90 days before departure. **Failure to make final payment by 90 days prior to departure results in automatic cancellation, forfeiture of the \$500 deposit, and potential additional fees.**

Imagine Tours and Travel, LLC (hereafter referred to as *Imagine*) reserves the right to impose a surcharge if the dollar declines by more than 2% against the destination currency based on booking date (05/19/26).

GROUP SIZE & SUPPLEMENTS:

Tour pricing assumes a minimum group size of 20 passengers.

Smaller groups may incur supplements:

- \$150 per person (19-16 travelers)
- \$195 per person (15-14 travelers)
- \$295 per person (13-12 travelers)

Tours with fewer than 12 travelers may be canceled due to insufficient participation.

ACCOMMODATIONS:

Price is based on double occupancy (two people sharing a room). Single rooms may be smaller than double rooms and, when available, incur an **additional supplemental charge of \$1,395 for the basic itinerary.** Roommates are assigned if available; otherwise, single-room occupancy may apply. *Roommates may be assigned as late as 120 days prior to departure when applicable.*

ITINERARY & CHANGES:

Imagine reserves the right to adjust itineraries due to airline schedule changes. Changes requiring extra nights incur \$195 per person per night (\$295 for single rooms). You will be notified in writing of said changes when possible. Meals for additional overnights are not included. Changes and/or deviations from the program and/or departure city listed by the passenger must be provided in writing no later than 120 days prior to departure.

All deviations are subject to a \$250 administrative fee plus applicable airline fees. All tours are made final at 90 days prior to departure.

No changes (including additions) may be made after this time.

LAND ONLY:

Land Only price is \$4,665 per person, excluding international flights.

Land Only passengers may be responsible for transfers and/or additional overnights incurred by booking their own flights. Passengers changing from the regular tour (with group airfare) to Land Only after 120 days prior to departure will be charged a fee of \$195 per person.

AIRLINE TICKETS & SEATING:

Flight routing is at the sole discretion of the airline, not *Imagine*. *Imagine* does not guarantee passengers will be on the most direct flight or flying together to the final destination (especially prior to 120 days of departure). Flights are economy class on IATA/ARC carriers with non-refundable, non-amendable tickets for groups of 10 or more. Group airfare pricing is based on the original group air contract secured by *Imagine*. Once contracted air inventory has been filled, any additional airfare secured for passengers—whether due to late registration, post-final payment additions, or changes requested by the passenger—**may be subject to increased costs**, which are the responsibility of the passenger. As such, *Imagine* cannot guarantee that all travelers will be booked on the same flights, particularly for passengers added after the final payment deadline as outlined in *PAYMENTS & FEES*, if airfare is applicable. Due to

group rates, *Imagine* does not participate in or allow passengers to use points, miles, vouchers, or other airline-related programs on group contracted airfare. Seat upgrades, cabin/class upgrades, or paid seating enhancements are not available through *Imagine* on group contracted airfare. All airfare provided under group contracts is economy class only. Seating requests are at the discretion of the applicable airline and cannot be guaranteed. All requests, including seating, dietary restrictions, and/or other accommodations must be made in writing prior to 120 days of departure. Any specific requests regarding seat assignments, seat upgrades, or cabin/class changes must be handled directly with the airline if permitted under the airline's fare rules once tickets have been issued, and remain subject to airline policies, availability, and additional fees. *Imagine* is unable to request, manage, or guarantee these changes on behalf of the passenger. Airline changes, if allowable, made by the passenger after 120 days prior to departure will incur additional fees. Individual ticketing fees and/or deposits may apply in certain situations. **These fees can be up to \$2,000 per person and will be applied to the final balance.**

FLIGHT TIMES:

All flight times are subject to change without notice. *Imagine* is not liable for expenses resulting from flight delays or changes. If making your own flight arrangements to a departure city or any other portion of your trip, we recommend obtaining a ticket which can be changed without large penalties. All passengers are responsible for reconfirming their flights with the airline 24 hours prior to departure.

PASSPORTS & VISAS:

Passengers must ensure their **passports are valid for at least six months beyond the return date of their trip** and submit a valid passport copy to our office no later than 120 days prior to departure. Visa requirements vary by country, and it is each passenger's responsibility to obtain necessary visas prior to travel. ***Imagine* is not liable for obtaining any required travel visas.**

TRIP RESCHEDULING:

Imagine and/or the group leader/organization reserves the right to reschedule the trip to **future dates and/or a different destination** due to governmental action, pandemics, wars, or other circumstances beyond their control. Travelers unable to travel on the new dates or to the updated destination may transfer to another tour within one year of the original travel dates, subject to fees of up to \$300 per person, plus any applicable fees imposed by ground operators, airlines, or other vendors.

CANCELLATION FEES:

Passengers cancelling from the day of registration up to 121 days prior to departure **will be charged a \$500 administrative fee** plus any airline penalties, if applicable. If passenger cancellation forces a roommate into a single room, the canceled passenger may be charged their single room fee. ↴

Changes to the tour cannot be made within 90 days of departure, as the tour is considered closed at that time.

The ITINERARY

Day 1 – Saturday, November 6: Across the Atlantic to Egypt

Today, tour members gather at their respective airports for the flight to Cairo. Sit back, relax, and enjoy the onboard entertainment as we journey toward Egypt. Tomorrow, we'll step into the cradle of civilization and begin our unforgettable adventure.

Day 2 – Sunday, November 7: Arrival in Cairo

Ahlan! Welcome to Egypt. Upon arrival at Cairo International Airport, we'll be greeted by our local representative and transferred to the Cairo Sheraton Hotel. After check-in, we'll enjoy dinner and relax overnight, preparing for the exciting days ahead.

Day 3 – Monday, November 8: Meet, Greet, and Mummies

After breakfast, we'll gather in the hotel conference room for a special meet-and-greet and teaching session as we begin exploring the world of biblical Egyptology together. We'll discuss important figures and pharaohs connected to the biblical narrative and prepare for the incredible sites we'll encounter throughout the journey. Later, we'll visit the National Museum of Egyptian Civilization to see remarkable artifacts and royal mummies connected to Egypt's past and the world of the Exodus. Along the way, we'll gain a deeper understanding of ancient Egyptian culture and history. Lunch will be enjoyed at a local restaurant during the day. If time allows, we'll also visit several historic churches in Coptic Cairo, home to some of Egypt's oldest Christian sites. Dinner and overnight are back at our hotel.

Day 4 – Tuesday, November 9: The GEM, Great Pyramid, and Guardian of Giza

Today we'll explore some of the most iconic treasures and monuments in all of Egypt. Our morning begins at the Grand Egyptian Museum, home to the incredible collection of artifacts from the tomb of Tutankhamun, along with countless treasures spanning Egypt's long history. We'll also see the massive Solar Boat of Khufu and artifacts connected to the world of Genesis and Exodus, including discoveries from the land of Goshen that we'll later visit together during the tour. Later, we'll stand before the legendary Pyramids of Giza, the last surviving wonder of the ancient world. You'll have the option to enter the Great Pyramid of Khufu or join Nate for a special fossil walk-and-talk around the Giza Plateau, exploring the limestone layers and natural history beneath our feet. We'll also visit the famous Great Sphinx of Giza before returning to the hotel. Dinner and overnight are back at our hotel.

Day 5 – Wednesday, November 10: The Temples of Thebes in the Land of Luxor

This morning we'll take an early flight south to the ancient city of Luxor, often called the world's greatest open-air museum. Upon arrival, we'll begin a full day exploring the remarkable temples and artifacts of ancient Thebes. Our first stop will be the magnificent Karnak Temple Complex, one of the largest religious complexes ever built. As we walk among its towering columns, obelisks, and massive gateways, we'll highlight important connections to the biblical world and the power of the pharaohs who ruled during Egypt's imperial age. Later, we'll visit the Luxor Museum, home to beautifully preserved statues, mummies, and artifacts from the New Kingdom period. In the late afternoon, we'll explore the illuminated beauty of Luxor Temple as the setting sun casts warm light across its ancient stones. Dinner and overnight at the Steigenberger Achte Luxor.

Day 6 – Thursday, November 11: Tut, Tombs, and Towering Tributes

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll cross to the west bank of the Nile to explore the ancient necropolis of Thebes. Our day begins in the famous Valley of the Kings, burial place of many of Egypt's

pharaohs, including King Tut. As we descend into these beautifully decorated tombs, we'll discover vivid scenes and inscriptions that reveal the beliefs and royal traditions of ancient Egypt. We'll then visit the Mortuary Temple of Hatshepsut at Deir el-Bahari, one of Egypt's most striking architectural achievements, built into the cliffs of the western desert. Later, we'll explore the impressive temple of Medinet Habu, known for its massive walls, colorful reliefs, and detailed historical inscriptions, before stopping at the towering Colossi of Memnon. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 7 – Friday, November 12: Pharaohs, Foundations & First Pyramids

After an early breakfast, we'll fly back to Cairo and begin a fascinating journey into some of Egypt's oldest royal sites. We'll visit Saqqara to explore the famous Step Pyramid of Djoser, the world's earliest large-scale stone pyramid and a major milestone in ancient architecture. Later, we'll visit Dahshur, home to the Bent Pyramid and Red Pyramid, where we'll trace the development of pyramid construction leading up to the great pyramids at Giza. Throughout the day, we'll discuss the history, engineering, and biblical backdrop of these remarkable monuments. Dinner and overnight are at the Sheraton Cairo Hotel.

Day 8 – Saturday, November 13: Faiyum Oasis and the Time of Joseph

After breakfast at the hotel, we'll depart Cairo for a full-day excursion into the Faiyum Oasis region, an area rich in both history and biblical significance. Our visits will include the Hawara and Lahun Pyramids, mudbrick complexes dating to the era of the biblical patriarchs and possibly even the time of Joseph himself. Along the way, we'll discuss the Middle Kingdom pharaohs, the 12th Dynasty capital of Itjtawy, and the historical setting surrounding Joseph's rise to power in Egypt. We'll also visit the striking Meidum Pyramid, one of Egypt's earliest pyramid attempts and among the most unique structures still standing today. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 9 – Sunday, November 14: From Goshen to the Red Sea

After breakfast, we'll pack our bags on the bus and depart Cairo for a full day exploring the biblical land of Goshen. Traveling into the Nile Delta, we'll visit Tanis, a site filled with fallen statues, temple ruins, and monuments connected to Egypt's ancient capital cities. Throughout the day, we'll discuss the Israelite presence in Egypt, the Exodus narrative, and the historical setting surrounding these events. From there, we'll symbolically "make our Exodus" from Goshen as we journey eastward across the desert toward the shores of the Red Sea, following the path of one of the Bible's most dramatic events. Dinner and overnight at the Red Sea at the Mövenpick Resort El Sokhna.

Day 10 – Monday, November 15: Red Sea Relaxation & Reflection

After breakfast, we'll gather together for a special wrap-up time with Nate as we reflect on the experiences, discoveries, and biblical connections from our week across Egypt. This will be an opportunity to share memories, ask final questions, and bring the journey together before returning home. The remainder of the day will be free to relax and enjoy the sunshine and beaches along the Red Sea coast. In the evening, we'll transfer back to Cairo for our final overnight stay before departure. Dinner and overnight at the Le Méridien Cairo Airport.

Day 11 – Tuesday, November 16: Farewells & Flights Home

After an early breakfast at the hotel, we'll transfer to Cairo International Airport for our return flights home. As our journey comes to an end, we leave Egypt with unforgettable memories, new friendships, and a deeper appreciation for the history, culture, and biblical world we've experienced together throughout the week.
